WHAT IS THE PAST PARTICIPLE? - Qu'est-ce que c'est le participe passé?

Le participe passé est employé pour exprimer une action passée. The Past Participle is used to express that an action has already _____. In English we usually use "ed" - (finished) some exceptions "sold" "threw" "wrote" "bought" ...etc).

French also has special endings for the Past Participle. For regular verbs ending in er, ir and re, the past participle is formed by:

To help you to remember the verbs that take être, think of a couple named Dr. and Mrs. Vandertramp. Each letter in their name stands for a verb that takes être in the past tense in French. This famous acronym is often used in French classes to help you to remember these verbs. Here is a list of those verbs which take être along with their past participles (refer to your created poster). In addition to the past participles, one must consider the MASCULINE/FEMININE -SINGULAR/PLURAL.
